Report on University Admissions

The Fall 2014, Winter 2015, and Summer 2015 graduates of Marianopolis College were contacted and asked what they were doing for the 2015-2016 academic year. They were asked whether or not they were continuing their education and if they were, to specify the institution and program. Of the 828 graduates, information was obtained from 676 or 81.6% of the students. The following is a summary of the results of the survey:
