## Report on University Admissions

The Fall 2017, Winter and Summer 2018 graduates of Marianopolis College were contacted and asked what they were doing for the 2018-2019 academic year.

They were asked whether or not they were continuing their education and if they were, to specify the institution and program. Of the 858 graduates, information was obtained from 724 or 84.3% of the students. The following is a summary of the results of the survey:
